

	Notes	Average cost of gun-shot victims treated and released the same day = <b>\$1,428</b> (ER base cost) Average cost of gun-shot victims requiring surgery and hospital stay = <b>\$87,097</b> (surgery cost) + <b>\$56,092</b> (hospital stay & rehabilitation center) Average cost of gun-shot victims who required surgery, a hospital stay, and were released to rehabilitation centers = <b>\$144,617</b> (ER cost, surgery & rehabilitation cost) Formula for this study: (Base cost + surgery cost - 1/5 (20%) of surgery cost) = <b>\$70,820</b> per shooting victim requiring surgery and rehabilitation.
