

	Notes	Average cost of gun-shot victims treated and released the same day = \$1,428 (ER base cost) Average cost of gun-shot victims requiring surgery and hospital stay = \$87,097 (surgery cost) + \$56,092 (hospital stay & rehabilitation center) Average cost of gun-shot victims who required surgery, a hospital stay, and were released to rehabilitation centers = \$144,617 (ER cost, surgery & rehabilitation cost) Formula for this study: (Base cost + surgery cost - 1/5 (20%) of surgery cost) = \$70,820 per shooting victim requiring surgery and rehabilitation.

An average of 125 hours is spent on attempted murder cases and 200 hours for homicides cases. \$47/hr (Detective) x 125 hours = \$5,875 \$47/hr (Detective) x 200 hours = \$9,400 	1087 hours to defend & prosecute a murder case x \$84 (DA \$44/hr + PD \$40/hr) = \$91,308 + 10% overhead = \$100,438.
